Recipe of the Month from our Chef Mark

Cheese Scones

300g self raising flour
1 tsp baking powder
240 ml semi skimmed milk
1 tsp sunflower oil
1 egg
75g grated cheese
1 tsp mustard powder

1. Sift flour and baking powder into a bowl.
2. Break egg into a jug and add oil and milk, until you get 250ml of liquid, mix well.
3. Add liquid mix to flour and then add cheese; mix until a dough is formed.
4. Turn onto floured worktop and roll out until 1 inch thick; cut into desired shapes. Place onto a floured baking tray and brush with milk or beaten egg.
5. Bake for 12-15 mins in oven and cook at 220 degrees/gas mark 7.
6. Cool on a wire rack.
